

## ANNA NEIERS

Anna Neiers (spelled Nevers on her birth record) was the second of six children (four daughters and two sons---both named Heinrich) born to Johannes Nevers and his wife Eva Winkel. Anna was born in Trintingen (now Trintange), Waldbredimus Commune, Remich Canton of Luxembourg on 4 August 1824. She grew up with a farm background for her father like his father Francis and uncle Nicolas Neiers were all farmers in the Trintange area. Her father was born in Trintange but his father and uncle Nicolas came there from Hassel, Weiler Tour. There the Neiers can be traced back to Anna's great, great grandfather Peter Nevers. Peter Nevers was also known as Peter Molter. His wife's name was Maria Molter which raises the question as to why he was also known as Molter. Perhaps he was raised by a Molter family and then married one of them. While Maria Molter's parents are known, the repetition of the names of Joannis and Maria in the generations raises questions about earlier Molter connections. Anna's ancestry is recorded back to her great, great, great grandparents in the late 1600's on the side of her father's mother Catharina Weinand. Anna's mother Eva Winkel was born in Filsdorf of the Dalheim Commune. Eva's father Francis Winkel came to Filsdorf from Breistrof (Braidorf), France, which was then a part of Luxembourg. The records are not clear but it is thought that his parents were John Winkel, son of Adam Winkel and Margaretha Schmidt, and Susanna Hilgert. Eva's mother Margaretha Kistges' lineage traces back through Kistges, Schlexer, Austges or Austgen and Kees to the early 1700's and even 1600's in Dalheim. The repetition of the name of Susanna and Joannis in the generations of the Schlexer line may cause confusion.

On 27 March 1851, Anna married Peter Guidinger, a 24 year old farmer. Peter was born in Welfrange but was then living in Altwies. According to the Waldbredimus marriage record she was 27 years old but she would not have been that until August. Anna and Peter may have become acquainted through relatives. Anna's mother Eva was an aunt of Peter's sister Margaretha's husband Nicolas Winkel.

Anna and Peter probably left for America quite soon after they were married for they arrived in New York on 3 June 1851. Their trip by land to the port at Le Havre, France would have taken about a week then. Whether the ship *Kate Hunter* was a sailing vessel or a steamship would have determined their length of time at sea. At that time, steamships also had sails. The advertised rates in the 1850's for steamers from Le Havre to New York for first class ranged from 450 to 500 francs for two adults in one chamber. Second class rates were from 120 to 260 francs for four adults in one chamber. Children of ages 1 to 10 were 150 francs and for under one year 50 francs. Some lines sailed direct while others stopped at Southampton, England. Records show that 21,173 emigrants left Le Havre's port for New York in 1851. One wonders

how Anna felt on the voyage for she was pregnant. John, her first child, was born exactly nine months after her marriage.

In any case, Anna did not have an easy life during their early years clearing the land and developing a farm in this country. There was living in a small log cabin later replaced by a small frame home which was later enlarged, giving birth to twelve babies in fifteen and a half years and the hard work involved in raising her children. Years after her death, her third son Nicholas spoke of his appreciation for the hardships she had endured and of his great respect for her. He described her as a short, sturdy, cheerful person. Anna died at age sixty on 21 May 1885 and was buried at Mequon, Wisconsin. Her life near Mequon in Ozaukee County, Wisconsin and the list of her children are found under the account on her husband Peter Guidinger.

All of the above ancestors of Anna Neiers were born in what was then Luxembourg. Breistroff, France or Breisdorf was a part of Luxembourg during their time.

It is interesting to note that Anna's great, great grandmother Maria Molter's brother Joannes (\*\*\*\*\*), who married Anna Seyvert, was the father of Elisabeth Molter (\*\*\*\*\*), who was the maternal grandmother of Margaretha Pary, mother of Anna's husband Peter Guidinger.

The Joannis Molter, who died before 1713, likely had a brother Cornelius as well as a son by that name for a Cornelius Molters and Susanna had a son Franciscus b. 8 Nov 1721. Also a son or brother Nicolas who with his wife Maria had a son Nicolous born 28 April 1716.

Baptismal sponsors were often relatives. Their names have been listed whenever they are a help in establishing connections between families.

Heinrich Nevers (\*\*\*\*) was the uncle of Anna Neiers who was shot by Anna's husband Peter Guidinger.

✓ Joannis Winkel (\*\*\*), the brother of Eva Winkel, was the father of Nicolous Winkel, who married Margaretha Guidinger, Jean Guidinger and Margaretha Pary's second daughter. He also is the great, great, great grandfather of John W. Kruse 2401 Blackthorn St., Newport Beach, CA 92660 who supplied the pictures of Luxembourg, the village maps of Filsdorf and Welfrange and the pages from the book "Three Hundred Year Chronology on the Houses and Families of the Dalheim Community".

As with previous family members, I have photographed the records for the included data on Anna's ancestry, but have not included all of them because of their bulk. Copies are available.

Anna Nevers was born on the fourth of August at 7 P.M. in 1824 in Trintingen (now Trintange), in the Waldbredimus Commune of the Remich Canton of the Duchy of Luxembourg. Her parents were Johannes (John) Nevers, a farmer, and Eva Winkel. Her father declared the birth at six the next morning.
